Items Discussed:

- 1) School council introduced themselves for each year group. Mrs Carey introduced herself and explained her role
- 2) The children were given the chance to discuss what school council meant to them and why they were there. Iggy discussed his concerns for the animals and climate change; he wants to help stop deforestation, overfishing and help raise awareness of climate change. Mrs Carey suggested we do some work around raising awareness of how to stop climate change and factors that affect animal habitats. Violet and Hudson also agreed they wanted to help with this. Rosie discussed how she liked the litter pick last year and would like to do something similar – helping the school and wider community.
The children then discussed how they want to raise money for charity – charities such as Veterans At Ease, families who need money for clothes and medication and Team Water were all discussed. Mrs Carey suggested choosing the charities they felt most passionately about and splitting the funds raised between them.

The children also discussed more equipment on the yard such as cricket and equipment, footballs and basketball hoops, how the assemblies can be uncomfortable and how they would like to use the climbing equipment in PE (Mrs Carey to speak to Mrs Elliott).

Finally, Violet discussed wanting a wider variety of awards in assembly – to be raised with Mr Wisby.
