Items Discussed:

- 1) School council contract discussed – Mrs Carey suggested a contract to outline the expectations of the role. All were in favour. Mrs Carey to print off when printers are working.
- 2) Badges – years 1, 3, 4, 5. Iggy, Leah, Sultan, needs new badge – Mrs Carey to speak to Mrs Cairns and get some new ones ordered. Pin badges suggested as many children have lost the magnetic back of their badges.
- 3) School council discussed making suggestion boxes for their peers could put their ideas in a box and they would monitor and present at meetings. Mrs Carey to find/order boxes and make template for suggestion sheet.
- 4) We talked about targets for the upcoming year. All voted in favour of a target around helping the local community/environment. Violet talked about litter in the community and the impact it has on plants and animals. Discussions around inviting someone from the council to do assemblies about the environment, a regular litter pick (class rota), contacting the council and working on posters to encourage/remind people to use bins. Rosie thought bins aren't cleared often enough and all children thought that there aren't enough bins in the community. Mrs Carey spoke to Mr Wisby regarding this – Mr Wisby to speak to John Adams about the bin clearance/lack of bins and how to get posters placed in the local community.
- 5) Rosie noticed the tables in the library are broken and sharp at edges – Mrs Carey to mention to Mr Nicholson.
- 6) Rosie said stickers don't last as a rewards – Mrs Carey stated that pin badges are more expensive hence why stickers and Dojo points are used.
Erian commented that there are no signs on the boys or girls toilets – boys and girls in ks2 don't have signs, Erian to action and make before half term.
Faizan suggested Accelerated reader awards in assembly. Children suggested other awards like writers award, friend award, maths award etc. Mr Wisby to introduce in assemblies.
Shayaan said he's noticed some children are sitting by themselves at playtimes. Discussions around a buddy bench – Leah wanted to make a sign and decorate a bench in the yard. Council keen to introduce in an assembly. Mrs Carey to speak to Mr Wisby about introducing this.
Violet and Leah said the classes and toilet passes need monitors to help their classes run smoothly. Mrs Carey to communicate to staff.
