### Items Discussed:

- 1) School council wanted whole school litter picks – Mrs Carey has set a timetable for children to go out monthly. School council were pleased that this was going ahead.
- 2) Bench – Mrs Carey has spoken to Mrs Hooker about getting a carpenter involved with the bench making – Mrs Carey awaiting details from Mrs Hooker.
- 3) Children were asked to give some feedback about school meals. Children shared their views.
- 4) School has received some craft kits from a company who would like some feedback about the contents and activities. School council given a craft box to take home. Children to give feedback in next session.
- 5) Children from KS2 brought the suggestion boxes to share. Suggestions included:
  - having a reflection room that children could go to if they were struggling with their emotions. School council agreed that classes have sensory toys if needed, the sensory room is suitable for that plus the LRZ is use for reflection when behaviour hasn't been good.
  - Ideas for clubs – one suggestion was for a games club where children could create their own board games and share with others.
  - Instead of having a Christmas song performance, it was suggested to have a panto where children could audition for parts. Mrs Carey said we could look at having a theatre club and perhaps having a summer panto/performance. Mrs Carey to speak to Mrs Murray about whether Maggie could do a performance club.
- 6) Speak to playground leaders and Mrs Elliott about checking equipment especially tennis.
